

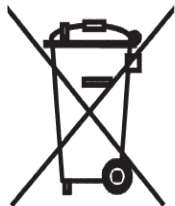
The Disposal of Electrical and Electronic Products

The United Kingdom is under obligation to minimise Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) in domestic waste and to encourage the reuse, recycling and environmentally sound disposal. If left in landfill sites, WEEE articles can have a harmful effect on the environment and human health. The WEEE directive is now UK Law.

JYSK UK is committed to promoting the reuse, recycling and sound disposal of WEEE and offers a take back service for all customers who have purchased products which fall within the WEEE legislation. In compliance with the legislation, JYSK UK will accept the return of "like for like" products. JYSK UK will not accept any WEEE products where a purchase of a similar product has not been made in store.

Proof of purchase (store receipt) is required if you wish to return a WEEE product. Customers have 28 days from the date of purchase to return the used product. This does not affect your statutory rights.

JYSK UK does not offer a home collection service, customers wishing to bring products to the store must do so themselves. Under the WEEE regulations all new electrical goods should now be marked with crossed out wheeled bin symbol shown below;
